Associazione N.9, like everyone else, is bound by the Italian Personal Data Protection Authority (GDPD).

General visit statistics are kept by We Are Paesani, without identifying visitors. Like the IP address and the operating system you use, webbrowser and the most frequently requested pages. The purpose of which is to optimise the lay-out of We Are Paesani. This data can also be used to publish more detailed information on We Are Paesani. This way Associazione N.9 can further optimize the service to you.

Personal data are stored in digital and paper format. The maximum retention period of the collected data is ten years (e.g. for accounting and tax purposes and in all other cases for which current legislation allows data to be kept for this period). The retention period provided for commercial and marketing purposes is three years.

The interested party can request access to his personal data at any time by making a request to the Data Controller.

Access to personal data may also be granted by the Data Controller to employees and collaborators, within the limits established and governed in the relationship with the latter, where this is necessary for the purpose of carrying out the tasks assigned to them and the activities carried out by them. The aforementioned access takes place in compliance with the technical and organizational measures adopted by the Data Controller for the purposes of protecting and safeguarding personal data.

The processing of personal data, both in paper and digital / computer format, takes place in compliance with the principles established by the GDPR, preventing - with appropriate technical and organizational measures - unauthorized or illegal processing or the loss, destruction or damage of data held by the Data Controller.

The personal data provided are not subject to disclosure, except in cases where this is required by current legislation or is necessary for the management of the services requested.
